Location/Date	July 30, 2016 Swift Field, South Colton, NY There will be 4 fields for play.
Format	6 vs 6 with goalies
Divisions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High School (enrolled in Grades 9-12 Fall 2016) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Boys ○ Girls • Open (ages 18 to unlimited) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Co-ed – No specific requirements, open to all.
Teams	<p>Team must register in either the high school division or open division. Maximum number of players on team is 12. Each player must complete registration form and designate which team they are playing for. Player cannot play for more than one team. Each player must sign waiver portion of registration. Under 18, must be signed by parent or guardian. Teams must have two jerseys/shirts, one light , one dark.</p>
Cost	Each player must pay entry fee of \$15.
Registration Deadline	July 15, 2016 (this allows the tournament to establish schedules and brackets in advance of the tourney)
Field	Field will be approximately 80 yards by 80 yards (half field, played sideline to sideline) with regulation nets. Fields will be lined with corner markers.
Rules	See separate document. (Still being constructed)
Officials	An official will be provided for each game.
Games	Currently, we are looking at 30 minute games, running time, with a short halftime break, quick restarts, no throw-ins, and limiting goalie ball handling (no punts or throws).
